

## **Jason M. Bristow Study Abroad Scholarship For Term-Long Study Abroad in Hungary or Poland**

**Application Deadline: April 15**

### **Scholarship Description**

The Study Abroad Program is accepting applications for the **Jason M. Bristow Study Abroad Scholarship**. This scholarship is an award of \$1,500 given to one student annually. All DePaul students studying for the first time in one of DePaul's term-long programs in Hungary or Poland are eligible, including adult and returning students.

**Eligibility:** Candidates must possess a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 and have been admitted to one of DePaul's term-long programs to Hungary or Poland. Preference is given to full-time students enrolled in the College of Commerce.

### **Recipients' responsibilities after receiving the scholarship:**

- ❑ Maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA during the program abroad
- ❑ Successfully participate in the indicated program.
- ❑ Carry out a project that promotes Study Abroad to other students at DePaul University.
- ❑ Participate in the Study Abroad might sound like only undergraduate students are eligible, but the eligibility section does not specify one way or the other) Conference during the Spring Quarter following the completion of the Study Abroad Program.

### **Materials to be submitted to the Study Abroad Program office by April 15:**

- ❑ Applicant's resume or CV
- ❑ Personal statement (maximum of 500 words), in which the applicant answers the following questions: (1) How does your participation in this particular program fit into your plans for the future? In answering this question, you may address your academic, career, and/or personal goals. (2) What challenges have you faced in arriving at the point where you are able to study abroad?
- ❑ A brief description of the applicant's follow-up project (maximum of 150 words). Projects should promote Study Abroad to other DePaul students. Examples include:
  - Presentations (to specific classes, student group or community members)
  - An exhibit or performance (photography or other creative work)
  - A scholarly article or series of articles to be presented at student conferences or published in student journals
- ❑ Two letters of recommendation from faculty or staff who know the quality of the applicant's academic work.

**Selection Process:** Applicants will be reviewed by a committee appointed by the Associate Vice President of International Programs. The committee may include faculty, staff, past scholarship recipients or other student leaders. The committee will make a recommendation to the Associate Vice President of International Programs, who will consult with the Financial Aid Office and the Director of Stewardship and Donor Relations in the Office of Development before making the final selection.

**Selection Criteria:** The committee will review the applications and make their recommendations based on the applicant's academic record, their articulation of the program's fit for their academic/career goals, and the originality and feasibility of the proposed follow-up project.
